Indication / Reason:

History: Intermittent shifting hindlimb lameness, no neurological deficits today, pain in caudal lumbar spine and hips.

DDx: lumbosacral stenosis, IVDD, hip osteoarthritis.

Examination Region: sagittal spine T1 onwards, concentrating on lumbar spine.

Examination:

- T2W sagittal FSE
- T1W sagittal
- T2W sagittal STIR
- T2W transverse
- T1W transverse
- T2W GRE
- T1W post-contrast sagittal
- T1W post-contrast F5 transverse.

Findings:

Periarticular Osteophyte formation of the right coxofemoral joint, with remodelling of the femoral neck. Slight increased fluid signal in the synovium, with slight contrast enhancement of the periarticular tissue.

The patient has normal caudal lumbar vertebrae

The lumbosacral junction is normal.

There is reduced T2W signal of the thoracic intervertebral discs.
